COMMERCIAL CARPET

Congratulations on your new flooring installation from Real Floors! Please follow these instructions to maintain the manufacturer & installation warranties.



Carpet needs to be vacuumed on a routine basis. Vacuuming removes loose dirt, dust and debris that can get into the carpet fibers and cause a permanent stain.



For spots and spills, blot the area starting from the outside and moving inward using a white towel. Do not rub at the spot, as this can damage the carpet fibers.



Try to use the least amount of solution possible. Select non-cationic detergents and spot cleaners sold especially for stain-resistant carpeting with neutral ph levels.



Prolonged exposure to excessive moisture may cause discoloration to the floor surface. Mildew and mold growth may form, typically underneath the surface.



If your efforts are unsuccessful, contact a professional carpet cleaner right away. Failure to act quickly will increase the odds of a permanent stain.



Use scissors to clip sprouts and snags in the carpet. Do not pull carpet strands or you may damage the carpet.



Limit direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time with use of blinds, shades, or awnings.
