Floor Care Instructions

IMPORTANT

Congratulations on your new flooring installation from Real Floors!

Please follow these instructions to maintain the manufacturer & installation warranties.



Never use ammonia or bleach to clean your vinyl flooring. Do not use detergents, abrasive cleaners or "mop and shine" products. They may damage your floor.



Never push, pull, or drag furniture, appliances or other items across the floor. Always lift and carry any items.



The adhesive under your floor needs time to thoroughly dry after installation. We recommend that you do not scrub or wash your floor for five days.



When using a vacuum cleaner, disengage the beater bar or use the "bare floor" setting to avoid damaging your flooring.



Wash the floor occasionally with a gentle (non-abrasive) floor cleaner. Always follow cleaning product instructions and adhere to cautions before use.



Do not use scouring pads, steel wool, sandpaper or other abrasive products.



Use non-staining felt protectors for all heavy furniture and furniture legs to reduce indentation. As a general rule of thumb, the heavier the item, the wider the floor protector needed.



Floor mats should be labeled non-staining. The use of rubber or latex-backed mats can permanently stain your floor. We suggest a non-staining vinyl-backed mat or a woven rug that is colorfast.



Limit direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time with use of blinds, shades, or awnings.



Do not use a steam cleaner or store-bought wet spray mops with cleaning solutions containing alcohol on vinyl surfaces.
