VINYL PLANK Floor Care Instructions

Congratulations on your new flooring installation from Real Floors! Please follow these instructions to maintain the manufacturer & installation warranties.



Do not wet mop floor for the first 48 hours after installation. After 48 hours you may damp mop or dust mop.



Do not use detergents, ammonia, bleach, abrasive cleaners or any "mop and shine" products. They may leave a dull film or damage your floor.



When using a vacuum cleaner, disengage the beater bar or use the "bare floor" setting to avoid damaging your flooring.



Do not use scouring pads, steel wool, sandpaper or other abrasive products.



Always remove excess water. Liquids not only can cause slip and fall hazards, but on unwelded plank floors, the water can attack the adhesive, break the bond, and cause the flooring to release from the substrate.



Do not set heavy items on plank for 24 hours after installation. Non-staining felt protectors are recommended for all heavy furniture and funiture legs.



Floor mats should be labeled non-staining. Oil or petroleum based products can result in discolorations.



Limit direct sunlight by closing blinds the first 48 hours after installation. Failing to do so may result in curling and gaping of the planks do to the increase heat generated from the direct sunlight.



Maintain room temperature between 65 and 85 degrees.
